2018 Kent Cup Championship

The 2018 Kent Cup is organised and administered by the Bayford Meadows Kart Club and Lydd Kart Club. The championship will consist of six rounds, three at each venue during the year. A competitor will count his best five scores for his final championship total.

Registration for the championship is free and automatic on entering the championship meetings. All six meetings are run as normal club meetings but the results will also count towards the Kent Cup. Meetings at Lydd will be run to IKR regulations whilst at Bayford Meadows meetings will be run to MSA regulations.

Classes invited

In addition to the normal MSA classes both clubs put a great deal of effort into providing cost effective class options for the club racers. In 2018 both clubs will promote the Junior (13+) and Senior Club-Max class (16+), basically a Rotax engine matched with long life tyres to provide performance and economy.

Additional Championships will be run for karts confirming to the MSA Gold Book in classes Junior/Senior Rotax Junior/Senior X30 provided there is a minimum of six entries per round.

Key points:

Entrants must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of Lydd or Bayford be eligible to race at the qualifying events. Competitors under the age of 18 must be countersigned by an adult.

Championship points will be awarded for the heats/finals as follows:

1st 50/25pts, 2nd 45/23pts, 3rd 43/22pts, 4th 41/21pts, 5th 39/20pts, reducing by 2/1pts down to 24th for 1 point.

All Non finishers will be classified in the order that they stopped.

If a meeting is stopped prior to the completion of the Pre-Final/Heats there will be no championship points awards.

In the event of the final not being run for whatever reason championship points will be awarded for the final grid position achieved.

If a meeting has to be cancelled for whatever reason the championship will be as many meetings run minus one round.

Ties shall be resolved using the formula in Section W.1.3.4 of the current MSA Yearbook.

Any driver excluded from an event for whatever reason will count that round as contributing to their total championship score with a 0 score.
