

# 2022 Kent Kart Championship

The 2022 Kent Cup is organised and administered by BMKR. The championship will consist of four rounds, two at Lydd and two at Bayford Meadows Kart Circuit.

Registration for the championship is free and automatic on entering the championship meetings. All four meetings are run as normal club meetings but the results will also count towards the Kent Kart Championship.

**BMKR Class Regulations apply at all rounds**

## Key points:

Entrants must be fully paid up members of BMKR or Lydd Kart Club to be eligible to race at the events. Competitors under the age of 18 must be countersigned by an adult.

Championship points will be awarded for the heats/finals as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> 50/25pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> 45/23pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> 43/22pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 41/21pts, 5<sup>th</sup> 39/20pts, reducing by 2/1pts down to 24<sup>th</sup> for 1 point.

All Non finishers will be classified in the order that they stopped. All rounds to count.

If a meeting is stopped prior to the completion of the Pre-Final/Heats there will be no championship points awards.

In the event of the final not being run for whatever reason championship points will be awarded for the final grid position achieved.

If a meeting has to be cancelled for whatever reason the championship will be as many meetings that are run.

Ties shall be resolved using the formula in Section W.1.3.4 of the current Motorsport UK Yearbook.

Any driver excluded from an event for whatever reason will count that round as contributing to their total championship score with a 0 score.

Championship awards will be 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in each class.
